Needs Assessment Update:

The EHE team is almost done with the development phase and will be entering into the implementation phase soon! The EHE team has been hard at work designing three surveys and focus group questions for those who are living with HIV and those who are at risk. Data collection will start in January 2020 and will end on April 30, 2020. The modes of data collection will be three surveys and 18 focus groups. The surveys will target community members, providers, and providers in training. The EHE team is currently recruiting agencies to host focus groups in Carson City, Clark County, Tonopah, Elko, Storey County, and Washoe County. If your agency is interested in hosting a focus group, please contact Victoria Young. The focus group will need a room for 90 minutes and help with participant recruitment, and the EHE team will do the rest. If your agency is interested in disseminating the surveys, please contact Victoria Young. We have incentives for focus group participants and clinics/agencies that help with the survey dissemination.

The EHE team will be working with Paula Frew, Ph.D., UNLV School of Public Health, for the messaging component of focus groups and plan. Paula introduced herself and described her experience working with HIV messaging material with the CDC.
