- o UCSD Cluster project will include molecular epidemiology tracking viral strands
- o Patients will only need to have a positive diagnosis to receive services
- Hiring an EHE Coordinator and finance person, to start around June 2020
- Depends on Congress for appropriation budget

- Targeted populations for assessment are transgender women, Latinx, African Americans, people who use drugs, people with insecurities with housing, food, and transportation.
