## II. Updates

The End, the Epidemic Nevada initiative, received a one-year grant from CDC through our Nevada Division of Public and Behavioral Health HIV Prevention Program to develop a Plan to End the Epidemic in Nevada. This one-year plan includes the development of an extensive needs assessment, which will include survey instrument and focus groups or town halls statewide. The focus of needs assessment will be people living with HIV, people at risk, and providers. The goal is to complete this needs assessment in 6-8 months and use this information, along with other sources of data, to write the plan. We are hoping for continued funding from the CDC to implement the plan but have not heard anything at this point. Similarly, we are planning for this needs assessment and intend to inform the next Integrated HIV Prevention and Care Plan.
