Meeting Notes

- I. Introduction- 63 member present
- II. Updates:

- Paula Frew UNLV team update: The content analysis on marketing in Nevada reviewed 196 pieces of material. Of the reviewed material, 47% of the material was focused on testing and screening, 17% of the material was focused on prevention, and 14% of the material was concentrated in PrEP. There is a gap in the marketing of HIV treatment in Nevada. Most of the content was directed to MSM and racial minorities.
- RW Part A: Nothing to update
- RW Part B: Not present
- SNHD/Fast Track Cities: Cheryl Radeloff requested the group to share the SNHD condom survey with EHE mailing list. EHE team agreed to send the survey out.
- State Prevention Program: The 2019 Nevada HIV Fast Facts is now available on the DHHS website.

- III. Statewide needs assessment update:

The EHE statewide assessment is in the data collection phase until April 30, 2020; analysis of the data will start in May. The CDC reviewed the EHE statewide needs assessment plan and recommended focusing on Clark County. The Clark County plan will be submitted in September of 2020 to the CDC. Per the CDC recommendations, the EHE coordinator is looking for contacts in mental health and substance use disorder providers, hospitals, payers, and corrections in Clark County. Anyone with those contacts is requested to share the EHE surveys. The EHE statewide plan will be drafted from October to December 2020 this year, using data collected from Washoe, Carson City, Elko, Esmeralda, and Storey County.

Surveys update:

- Total number of responses for the community survey 113, Clark County 28
 - Total number of responses for the provider survey 97, Clark County 26
- A more robust response is needed in Clark County, and the EHE team asked those on the phone call to share the survey

Focus groups update:

- Fifteen focus groups have been completed in four counties, with 137 participants. The EHE coordinator reviewed the one-page focus group participant summary. Focus groups data is currently being transcribed and coded for analysis to start in May.
