Introductions of the EHE team and those who on the call.

Updates:

- Paula Frew UNLV team – They will have some marketing samples for the group to review in August.
- RW Part A – announced they would be posting a job announcement for their EHE coordinator soon.
- RW Part B – Not present
- SNHD/Fast Track Cities – Jessica Johnson announced they have some staff turnover with their new EHE community educator.
- State Prevention Programs – The state has also had staff turnover on the surveillance side.

Statewide needs assessment update:

NAETC Needs Assessment Project Coordinator, Victoria, presented a PowerPoint containing the preliminary findings of community and provider engagement surveys and focus groups for Clark County.

Group discussion of the preliminary finding:

- Discussion of EHE goals for the CDC four pillars: Diagnose, Treat, Prevent, Respond
- The workgroup discussed and rewrote goals

Recommended policy changes:

- Universal testing in ERs, all lab testing, all PCP, and in all jails or opt-out testing.
- Youth sex education- proposal for comprehensive, evidence-based education for the state of Nevada
- Off-site, community-based testing,
- HOPWA eligibility- removing of minor offenses or prior eviction so more people can qualify for housing services.
- Decriminalizing HIV if molecular epidemiology is implemented
