Twenty-seven EHE partners from around the state called in

Updates:

Paula Frew UNLV team: The UNLV team has finish coding the Clark County focus group material and will be presenting a marketing proposal during the July EHE workshop meeting. Priority target populations were discussed: MSM, minorities, and possibly transgender or IDU.

SNHD/Fast Track Cities: Nikki Rachal was introduced. She is the new Fast Tracking/EHE community educator for Southern Nevada Health District

Lourdes also announced that her office is hiring a new educator as well.

State Prevention Program: Lyle announced that the state got approval from the CDC to hire an intern. The person should be hired between July and September of 2020.

Statewide needs assessment update:

Victoria: Timeline – We are in the data analysis phase

Surveys update:

- Total number of responses for the community survey is 229, Clark 81
- Total number of responses for the provider survey is 126, Clark 36
- Total number of responses for the provider-in-training is 127, Clark 55

Focus group update:

- Nineteen focus groups were held in Clark, Washoe, Elko, Esmeralda, Carson City, and Storey County. A total of 149 community participants and 94 providers were engaged in the focus group. A brief review of what the participants demographic were was discussed. How the COVID-19 pandemic an impact the focus group participant was also examined. The EHE project coordinator was unable to reach youth, people of low SES, and those who were homeless due to the pandemic and organization being closed.
