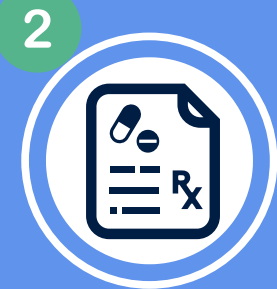


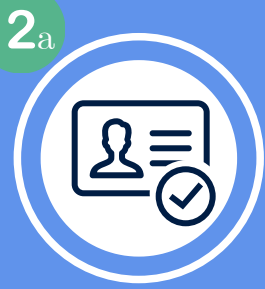

Client enrolls in Nevada Medication Assistance Program (NMAP)

NMAP pays client's health insurance premiums and client receives Pharmacy Benefit Manager (PBM) ID card

Client takes prescription (Rx) to pharmacy

Client presents health insurance and PBM ID card to pharmacy

Pharmacy fills Rx with stock of choice (340B or non-340B)

PBM pays clients medication cost-share

PBM submits claims to pharmaceutical company (in which non-340B stock was used)

NMAP generates less rebates per HRSA's duplicate discount prohibition

Client reaches health insurance out-of-pocket maximum

340B entity continues to dispense 340B medication

340B entity generates program income
