28 EHE Workgroup Members Present
Community and State update

- RW Part A-They are in the process of interviewing and hiring an EHE project coordinator. They hope to have that position filled soon.
- RW Part B-They have lost their ADAPT Coordinator, Quality Manager Coordinator, and a staff member who was a contractor under ADAPT who was handling health insurance; they will send out an email on who sub-recipients can contact. There has not been a decision if additional funding will come out for sub-recipients past July 30th, 2021. If you have concerns or questions, please contact Tory.
- SNHD/Fast Track Cities- On National HIV Testing Day, the Fast-Track Cities program had elected officials post videos on social media about the Collect-2-Protect program. The state attorney general and elected representative Stephen Horsford participated. They had several clicks on their social media about the Collect-2-Protect program. Southern Nevada's HIV Prevention Planning Group has a meeting this Friday (7/16/2021). The Empower Change: HIV Rapid Testing Training will happen at the end of this month.
- WCHD- No updates
- CCHHS-Not present
- State prevention programs- Sent out a bulletin to providers about academic detailing. The 2020 HIV Fast Facts will be presented during the Statewide HIV Prevention Planning Group meeting in August. The new HIV epi profile is on track to be published during December of 2021. They are also in the process of planning a needs assessment for the Integrated Care and Prevention Plan.
- PACE- The Ending the HIV Epidemic Quarterly meeting is on 7/14/2021. You will need to register.
- Clinics-The LGBTQ Center in Las Vegas has in-person and virtual clinics. The clinic is open 1–5 pm and offers free HIV, Hep C, and STD screening; they also take Medicaid and help with payment assistances if needed.
- Others- the Southern Nevada Health Consortium has a meeting on 7/23/2021 at the Nunnery at 3:00 pm. The meeting is open to all and is an in-person meeting. They are planning on a Latinx AIDS Awareness Day event in October and a Positively ART, which is on World AIDS Day, and a Human Red Ribbon Event as well.
- Huntridge Family Clinic has in-person, and telehealth appointments, and they are offering the COVID vaccine and offering free HIV testing as well.

Andre Wade, the State Director for Silver State Equality, Chair of the Governor's Task Force on HIV Transmission Modernization, and member of the Nevada Office of Minority Health and Equity's Advisory Committee, will be presenting on policies impacted by the last legislative session.
