

Nevada's Ending the Epidemic Workgroup Meeting Notes Monday, January 10th, 2022, 12–1 PM PT

Updates:

- RW Part A- They are working with Collaborative Research in designing a U=U campaign. They hosted a community focus group to weigh in on the campaign. The RFQ for the Rapid ART Strike Team is still in their accounting office but will be released soon, and they will share it with the group.
- RW Part B- They still have several open positions for hire. If you know anyone who needs a job, send them to Part-B to submit an application.
- SNHD/Fast Track Cities- Empower Change, the HIV Rapid Testing training is scheduled for 1/27/22 and 1/28/22. SNHD is also planning a disclosure training series with UMC.
