Updates:

- RW Part A: Requests for RFQs for all Ryan White services for the next three years were sent out. They also sent out a request for quotes on the Rapid stART Response Team, whose focus will be on capacity building and assistance across Clark County. Learning session 4 took place this month and had 17 agencies participate; they had 50 participants total.
- · RW Part B: Not present
- · SNHD/Fast Track Cities: Empower Change training is on July 8th and 9th at SNHD. SNHD is also working with Pacific AETC-NV to develop an HIV disclosure training for UMC that will take place in June.
- · WCHD: Not present
- · CCHHS: They are interested in collaborating with the state's educational manager, Veronic Gallos, who focuses on education for youth and young adults.
- State prevention programs: They had a PrEP Institute at the beginning of April with 40 participants. Southern HPPG meeting is scheduled for April 29th.
- · PACE: HHS released new AHEAD Dashboard data for three new indicators. The data has been updated in the new CDC data table. They are also investigating how to collaborate on multiple syndemics such as the syphilis epidemic, drug use epidemic, and mental health. HHS is also launching I am a work of ART to promote viral suppression; they will be traveling in Nevada and Arizona in June.
