• RW Part A: The entries for the Rapid stART Response Team Project are currently being scored. Once the scoring is complete, they will announce who was awarded those contracts. It may result in changes to their service providers and the services they deliver. They are currently planning their Learning Session Six for the Rapid StART Learning Collaborative; this is the first in-person meeting in three years. They are still waiting on the EHE award from HRSA, and they are expecting it to hit this week, and that is holding projects until the funding is awarded. • State prevention programs: SB211, the HIV/STI testing bill, did not pass forward. A physician wants to revisit the legislative language. They are also working on the 2021 HIV Fast Facts

• PACE: They are visiting their EHE jurisdiction in August, and they have identified needs for each jurisdiction and trying to support where ever they can.

• Southern Nevada Health Consortium: June 27 is National HIV Testing Day, and they are doing a public media campaign with all consortium members that are offering testing for free. They have another meeting on June 17 at CCC at 2:00 PM. They are planning for World AIDS Day, National Black HIV Awareness Day, and National Latinx Awareness Day events as well. The World AIDS Day event will include an art show that they are collaborating with multiple partners and will be at Commercial Center. The consortium is now a 501C3.
