Nevada's Ending the Epidemic Workgroup Meeting Notes Monday, May 9th, 2022, 12–1 PM PT

Updates:

- RW Part A: They are in the process of reviewing all FRQ applications. They also closed a request for quotes on Thursday for the Rapid stART Response Team. Their U=U campaign is coming out soon. They are brainstorming with Collaborative Research for the next learning sessions. They are working on motion graphics to teach community partners and health service providers how to navigate the rapid stART system.
- · RW Part B: Not present
- SNHD/Fast Track Cities: Empower Change Training in July is full. They are participating in the STI Update training in May. They are still working with the Pacific AETC-NV for an disclosure training for UMC staff in June.
- WCHD: They have a lot of new HIV diagnoses but are late testers and are very sick. They are also working on a syphilis project with the jails. This project will test anyone of childbearing age for syphilis. They are also still planning for a new PrEP program in Washoe County.
- CCHHS: No updates, but are happy to collaborate with WCHD for their new cases.
- State prevention programs: Not present
- PACE: No updates
- Southern Nevada Health Consortium: Planning public health campaign for national HIV testing day; they will promote all local partners that are testing for HIV. They are also planning a National Latinx HIV Awareness Day event. They are also doing a new event for HIV and Aging Awareness Day in December. Everyone is welcome to attend the Southern Nevada Health Consortium meetings.
- Center: They have planned a PrEP Rally at the Center in June. They will have vendor's tables, cheerleaders, drumline, and health services.
- Pacific AETC's STI Update on May 21 and 22 with skill-building sessions will include free breakfast and lunch.
- Planned Parenthood of the Rocky Mountains: They are providing outreach to the 89106 area codes areas and have been doing it for five weeks. They are also working with other community groups, such as the black panther liberation group. They also partnered with Horizon Ridge Clinic with their food pantry and mental health for the transient populations.
