

# HIV MODERNIZATION

**A person can only be charged with transmitting a communicable disease. Having HIV in itself is not a crime. Failing to use protection alone does not show intentional transmission. Engaging in sex work after testing positive for HIV as a felony has been repealed by Nevada State Senate Bill 275 in 2021. NRS 201.358 repealed.**

**Current medical or epidemiological evidence determine transmission likelihood.**

**Mandatory HIV testing requirements after being arrested for solicitation or engaging in unlawful sex work has been repealed by Nevada State Senate Bill 275 in 2021. NRS 201.356 repealed**

## **Exposed? Know your rights.**

- 1) If possible, explain the likelihood of exposure to your designated health care officer for likely communicable disease exposure.**
- 2) File a petition in court. A court will promptly determine whether you were likely exposed to a communicable disease.**
- 3) A person under investigation must not have their identity and medical information publicly disclosed.**
