Updates:

RW Part A: They are doing their first in-person learning collaborative for session 6 on 7/14 at Palace Station. They are preparing to recording their 2- 2022 Ryan White Conference Abstract Presentations, one for the learning collaborative and one for their Rapid stART initiatives. They are finishing up their TA sessions to address HIV stigma within the organization. They have also started working with QM and other departments within SNHD to created learning modules and a learning environment to address HIV stigma and to teach HIV basics in the organization.

PACE: HHS launched Viral Suppression campaign titled I am a work of ART and PACE is working with their partners to expand materials to be available in Spanish by participating in virtual support groups both in LA and Puerto Rico this month. Currently materials are only available in English. PACHA (The Presidential Advisory Council on HIV/AIDS) is coming to Los Angeles, Sept 19th- 20th. One of the days, community members will have a chance to meet with HHS, HERSA and CDC Leadership. The Assistant Secretary of Health is also invited. This is a hybrid meeting lead by the community for the community. They are also working to meet face to face with EHE partners and visit Clark county in late summer/ early fall to see how they can offer their support. Also offering support for World AIDS day to the organizations anyway they can.
