RW Part B: Part: They hired a new Part B coordinator, Ashley Martin, who started today. They also have a new epidemiologist, Fredricka Marin, in the State Preventions program.

They had 2 site visits in the last month, CDC and HRSA, and only a few findings and they are working through the recommendations.

SNHD/Fast Track Cities: EHE rethink safe sex campaign is being implemented on May $8^{\rm th}$. The Rethink HIV campaign is still ongoing, in both English and Spanish.

They are continuing to work on the pre-natal HIV project and materials and in the internal review process.

The next Empower Change training is scheduled for July 19th and 20th. They are looking into adding another training in May or June.

Completed first HIV stigma training at SNHD with 40 people from the FQHCs.

State prevention programs: They completed their CDC site visit in March and have a new epidemiologist on board, Fredricka Martin.
